

Where is My 1099-G From the State of Wisconsin

In prior years, one of the tax documents you might have received in the mail was the Wisconsin 1099-G reporting your prior year Wisconsin refund or overpayment. In an effort to reduce costs and improve efficiency, for 2011, 1099-G's will not be mailed to any person who electronically filed their 2010 tax return. Those who paper filed their return and did not opt to go paperless will still receive their 1099-G in the mail. Either you or your tax preparer can access the 1099-G form online to prepare your 2011 tax return. They are securely available on the Wisconsin Department of Revenue's website. The direct link is <http://www.revenue.wi.gov/eserv/Form1099G/index.html>. With this link you can look up your 1099-G and you can also sign up to go paperless for next year. To access your 1099-G you will need 3 things:

1. Full name
2. Social security number
3. Zip code

Those who have opted to go paperless and provided their e-mail address will receive an e-mail notification in early January that their 1099-G is now ready for lookup. To receive the e-mail notification you can sign up to go paperless even if you electronically filed your return last year.
